BSA has introduced a brand new training course for Cub Scout Leaders. This training lasts 3 hours and is intended to provide the basic information to help get a new leader off to a great start. It incorporates many of the details that were included in the old New Leaders Essentials Course. In order to be considered "fully trained", a Cub Scout Leader must complete Fast Start Training, Cub Scout Leader Specific Training, and Youth Protection Training.

Step 1: Fast Start (20 minutes)

Fast Start training can be completed in several ways:

Step 2: Leader Specific Training (3 hrs)

These training sessions feature discussions on issues specific to Cub Scout Pack Leadership, including specific leader training covering the Tiger, Wolf/Bear, Webelos, and Cubmaster/Committee positions and responsibilities. Training for the next Cub level is required each year.

For all new Cub Scout Leaders. Topics include: Personal goals, Youth Growth and Development, How you as a Leader fit into your unit and your district, Where to find help and support, Unit and District Finances, Safe Scouting, and Scouting Transitions.

Step 4: Youth Protection (60 minutes)

All registered leaders must complete this training within 90 days of registration.
Must be updated every 3 years.

Youth Protection training can be completed in two ways:

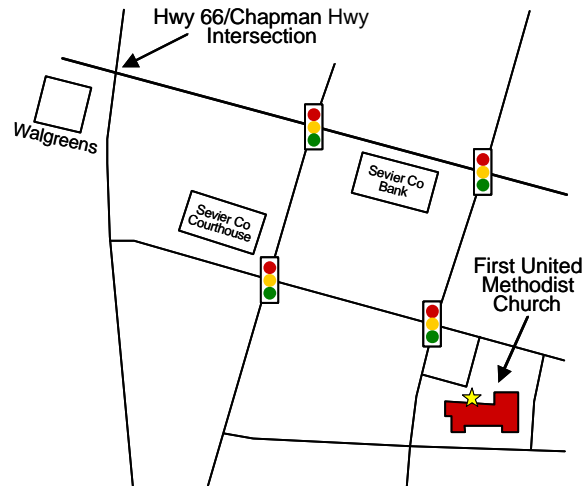

DIRECTIONS: From **the intersection of Hwy 66 and Chapman Hwy**, go south on Main St/Dolly Parton Pkwy and turn right at the second traffic light. Turn left at the first light (Bruce St). Take the first right into the parking area behind the church.

NOTE: *The training will be in a basement room of the church. Enter from the back of the church.*

Valley Grove Baptist Church, Seymour



DIRECTIONS: From **KNOXVILLE** go south on HWY 441 (*Chapman Highway*) to Simpson Road on Left. Valley Grove Baptist Church will be straight ahead.

From **SEVIERVILLE** go north on HWY 441 (*Chapman Highway*) to the Knox County line. Turn right on Sevierville Pike (Approximately 1/4 mile from Knox County line). Valley Grove Baptist Church will be 100 yards ahead on the right.
